DIRECTIONS

From Berkeley Springs, WV: Take RT 9 West 15½ miles to the Singing Hills Ranch. Range will be on your left and parking on your right.

From Winchester, VA: Take RT 522 North to Berkeley Springs, WV and follow the Berkeley Springs directions **OR Take** RT 522 North to RT 127, take RT 127 to RT 29 North to RT 9 East. Drive approximately six (6) miles to the Singing Hills Ranch. Range will be on your right and parking on your left.

From Cumberland, MD: Take RT 51 (Industrial Blvd. Exit) to Paw Paw, WV. When you cross the bridge, RT 51 becomes RT 9, go approximately four (4) miles, and turn left (still RT 9). Drive approximately six (6) miles to the Singing Hills Ranch. Range will be on your right and parking on your left.
